Obviously no lessons to be learned by either side there. Just as he was starting to settle in and had reached 33, a shocker of an LBW decision saw him heading back to the nest. Enter Adam and Mitch, who slowly but surely began to build the score. They copped a fair bit of sledging from their teammates on the sideline (mainly Pete) who were unaware that Adam had sustained a quad injury and was having difficulty running. Apologies were in order during the break, and the opposing skipper agreed to let Corie act as runner. Not long after, Adam was trapped in front bringing his gritty innings to a close on 28. We were still about 50 short at this stage, but Pete and Euan put up a bit of resistance for a few overs, only for Pete to eventually hole out to mid on, still 35 short.
