They copped a fair bit of sledging from their teammates on the sideline (mainly Pete) who were unaware that Adam had sustained a guad injury and was having difficulty running. Apologies were in order during the break, and the opposing skipper agreed to let Corie act as runner. Not long after, Adam was trapped in front bringing his gritty innings to a close on 28. We were still about 50 short at this stage, but Pete and Euan put up a bit of resistance for a few overs, only for Pete to eventually hole out to mid on, still 35 short.
