THE HISTORY

The U-12 Development Carnival (Ian Healy Cup) is conducted by BNJCA in January of each year. The event seems to have become a significant event on the calendar for a number of associations.

In 1999, the then BNJCA Director of Coaching Kenneth Hunt, felt that there should be cricket available in Brisbane of a higher standard than that played on Saturdays. He therefore suggested an annual carnival for players just below the standard of players selected to attend QJC Championships.

lan Healy was consulted and approved his name to be used for an U-12 Development Carnival to take place annually and for an Ian Healy Cup Perpetual Trophy to be awarded to the winning team.

Hosting of the Carnival from 1999 has been undertaken by the Albany Creek Cricket Club at their grounds at Brendale with the Bald Hills-Lawnton Lions Club becoming involved in 2009 with provision of a ground and supply of lunches at Canterbury Park, Bald Hills. It has now reverted back to just ACCC hosting the carnival. Steve and Kathy Casey have been the driving force behind every successful event hosted by the Hawks. The Presidential Couple is well supported by a team of club volunteers throughout the week.

In 1999 only Brisbane North teams were involved, subsequently BEARS, Metropolitan South West, Beaudesert, Beenleigh-Logan and Sunshine Coast became involved. BEARS have sent separate teams from Redlands and Eastern Districts, additional teams from Sunshine Coast, Gold Coast, Ipswich and Cricket Far North have attended.

Brisbane North teams have been victorious in claiming the cup six times since 1999, the most recent last year, by the Brisbane North Blue team.




