We are in the home straight now with only four weekends of cricket to finish off our 2018/19 season. We have been extremely lucky with the weather and dodged a huge bullet last weekend when there were prophesies of doom and gloom. You may all remember last season when we lost about six of our Friday nights in the Post Xmas season.

Over the Xmas period, our club hosted the Ian Healy Cup for Brisbane North. This is an U12 state wide carnival. Several Albany Creek Hawks players represented BNJCA teams where the teams came third and fourth out of 14 teams. Well done boys. I would like to acknowledge the great assistance from Kathy Casey, Eddie Mills, Peter McFarlane and Ross Duncan who helped each day. Nick Thomas and Stevo were able to assist on the last day with our BBQ. Ian Healy came along and spoke to the players and parents and presented the Cup. He is a great Queenslander and an excellent role model for our sport.

Our annual Pink Stumps Foundation fund raiser is under way at present. Thank you to those politicians who have offered financial assistance as well as prizes for the raffles. Over the past seven years we have been able to raise over \$30,000. I do encourage each team to get out and sell those tickets.

With our Presentation day coming up on Sunday 31st March, it is important for team officials to get those results in to our statistician ASAP after your games. We cannot award trophies to our players if we don't have stats.!!

In the coming weeks there will be work carried out on our North field. The MBRC is ripping up all of the turf, removing our existing pitch and placing it six or seven metres to the east, replacing the existing aged irrigation system, re-turfing the field and laser levelling the whole oval. This will allow our older players to play on a 70m boundary and remove all of the low spots that cause drainage problems during the wet. It will then be comparably to our South Field which under went the same process two years ago. Many visitors to our grounds regard the south field as one of the best playing surfaces in Brisbane. At certain times the nets and oval will be out of bounds. The fields should be right to go by September. Short term pain for long time gain.!!!

Good luck to all our players and officials for the remainder of the season.

Umpire - Out or Not Out?

- 1. The delivery is called wide, the batsman neither attempts a run nor makes her/his ground as the ball rebounds from the keeper's helmet onto the stumps. Only then makes her/his ground.
- 2. The umpire miscounts, and allows a 7th ball to be delivered; the bowler's fair delivery knocks over middle stump.
- 3. With three fielders behind square on the leg-side, the striker makes poor contact with the ball, then, frustrated with the shot, kicks the ball away.
- 4. The ball, a fair delivery, pitching outside off, strikes the batsman outside the line of off- stump as he/she makes no attempt to play it. The ball would have gone on to hit the stumps.
- 5. The bowler fairly delivers a slower ball which the batsman misses; it strikes the off-stump, and a bail slips from the top of off, but remains on top of the middle stump.
- 6. A ball, that would have gone on to hit the stumps, bounces twice outside off-stump, before striking the batsman's shin in line with the wicket.
- 7. A left-arm bowler bowls a ball right-armed, without telling the umpire; the delivery pitches outside off, strikes the batsman's pads in line with the wicket and would have hit the stumps.
- 8. On a fair delivery, the striker swings at the ball and edges it into the short-leg fielder's helmet; it glances off the helmet and is caught by the keeper.
- 9. The batsman misses the ball whilst standing on, but not behind, the popping crease; the ball rebounds off the wicket-keeper's pads and takes out leg-stump.
- 10. The batsman edges a fair delivery, the wicket-keeper tries to catch it; instead, it lodges in the keeper's pads.






