IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PARENTS - TEAM PLACEMENT POLICY

We do not grade players at Albany Creek Cricket Club. It is the policy of the club to attempt to place players according to the individual requests of the players. If no special requests are made, players will be placed in the appropriate age group.

To make it simpler for existing players to register for the next season, we will provide pre-filled registration forms on our club sign-on weekend. Please note - the registration form and the club's webpage form provides a special request section, so that parents can make requests for team placement as per examples:

- *Same team as last year*
- *With 'Sandy Wicket'*
- *With players from 'XYZ School'*

Registrations are also accepted by mail, email or via MyCricket and the Hawks webpage. Please note that registration forms must still be completed for the MyCricket option and forwarded to the Registrar.

Towards the end of each season we will publish the dates for next season's sign-on weekend in the newsletter and on the club's Webpage and Facebook page. We would also like to remind all parents to ensure that any changes in contact details are forwarded to the club to avoid missing out.

Increasing player numbers each year make the administrative task of organising teams more difficult. At the beginning of each season our registrar invests a great deal of time reviewing all player requests before allocating players to individual teams. This commences on Sign-on weekend and continues over several weeks, with new registrations and late registrations coming in right until (and sometimes well after) the season's first game. So please be sure about your special requests, it is extremely difficult to accommodate any late changes once the teams are formed. The process of sorting teams is long and involved and moving players around after it has started creates a logistical nightmare, especially since we also have to work around a deadline for nominating teams to the Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association.

We have in excess of nearly 400 players to keep happy, therefore if registrations are not received before and by the sign-on weekend, or the registrar is not advised of a player's intent to return and preferred playing arrangements, special requests can only be met if there is room in the nominated team.

GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

ANY CRICKET PROBLEMS? - ALL COMMITTEE PHONE NUMBERS ARE LISTED ON THE COMMITTEE PAGE

You have all had a little time to settle in and see how your team is going. Are there any problems? Please don't think now that the season has started that you are on your own. Phone and talk to any committee member or alternatively, approach your coach and we will try and fix what we can. Do not use Facebook as point of contact, the page is for news only.

HELMET POLICY

It is club policy that all **Batsmen MUST wear a helmet** when batting. **Wicket-Keepers MUST wear a helmet if keeping up close to the stumps**, regardless of the style of bowling. This is a Cricket Australia and Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association rule and as such non-negotiable. **NO HELMET—NO PLAY!!**

BATTING GLOVES PROTECTORS

Zone Rules 2.2 (d), (e), (f), (g) & (h) require **ALL** players to wear protection when batting - helmets, pads and gloves are available in each team kit. All players are issued with a personal protector when registering and **MUST** use them.

SAFETY - WET & COLD

Playing cricket can be extremely hot, so please ensure that player safety is a priority when deciding on the need to leave the field for a spell or not. It is important to ensure that all players apply sunscreen before the match and re-apply during every break. Players should wear a wide-brimmed hat and take regular drink breaks throughout the innings. In the event of rain consider player safety when assessing the field conditions to avoid slipping and dangerous play. Do not commence the match if the oval is deemed unsafe and wait for conditions to improve or make a decision to possibly abandon the match if necessary. **DON'T PUT PLAYERS AT RISK!!!**

COACH'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The coach runs the team. The coach is responsible for preparation of the players and control during the match. Batting and bowling orders are the coach's responsibility. It is recommended that from U13 upwards, a captain is appointed to run the team, particularly when fielding. The Hawks expect **ALL** coaches to have a basic Level 1 Coaching Certificate. It is the coach's responsibility to enforce the club's helmet policy and ensure that players wear all protective equipment as outlined above.

MANAGER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The manager assists the coach with the team administration. The manager should ensure that rostered parents are available to attend canteen duties (as required), act as umpires, scorers and generally assist players and team management throughout the game and training, i.e. organising batsmen to get ready. Managers are responsible for the publication and recording of match results and team statistics. U8 to U10 match abstracts are to be emailed to our statistician directly, U11 to Open Divisions must enter their match stats into the MyCricket online database. Under 11 to Open managers will also forward player of the round nominations to BNJCA as outlined in the coach's/manager's manual.



How Are The Winners Of Team Trophies Determined?!?!



At the end of the season, there are three trophies awarded to each team:

- ♦ Batting Award
- ♦ Bowling Award
- ♦ Coach's Award

The award recipients are determined based on the following principle:

- ♦ The **Batting Award** is always decided first.

The best average is used to determine the winner in senior grades [U11 to Open Divisions], while the junior grades [U8—U10] are determined by the best aggregate total (unless there is a draw, in which case, averages will be used to determine the winner). For senior grades, players must have played in 50% or more of the team's matches and be in the top 50% of run scorers. (see below for an example of how the top 50% of run scorers are determined)

- ♦ The **Bowling Award** is decided next.

(The winner of the batting award is not eligible for this award)

The best average is used to determine the winner in senior grades [U11 to Open Divisions], while the junior grades [U8—U10] are determined by the best aggregate total (unless there is a draw, in which case, averages will be used to determine the winner). For senior grades, players must have played in 50% or more of the team's matches and be in the top 50% of wicket takers. (see below for an example of how the top 50% of wicket takers are determined)

- ♦ The **Coach's Award** is the third.

(The winners of the batting and bowling awards are not eligible for this award)

The award recipient is chosen by the Coach and may be given for any reason what so ever. For example, the coach may decide to award a player who may not have been amongst the top batters, bowlers or fielders. This player displayed an exemplary attitude towards the game, team mates and coach throughout the season at training and every match.



How to calculate a Player's Average !?!!

The **Batting Average** is calculated by dividing the number of times the batter has been dismissed into the total runs scored for the season, e.g. 125 runs divided by 5 'outs', will give an average of 25.0

The **Bowling Average** is calculated by dividing the number of wickets taken by the bowler into the number of runs scored against the bowler, e.g. 100 runs conceded divided by 5 wickets taken will give an average on 20.0

The **Top 50% Run Scorers and Wicket Takers**

The team list is sorted from highest to lowest run scorer and wicket taker for the season. The top half of these are then eligible for the batting and bowling award, e.g. a team of 12 players will be sorted from the highest to the lowest batting aggregate for the season. The first 6 players on the list (50% of the number of players in the team) will then be reviewed and the one with the best average will be the award recipient - provided that they have played more at least 50% of the season's matches.

The same process will be applied to determine the bowling trophy winner through the bowling aggregate.

Match Results and Player Statistics

It is important that match results and players statistics are recorded as soon as possible after each completed match. Lock-out rules apply for late submissions by the respective associations for all matches played in the U11 to Open Divisions.

Under 8's to 10's

Statistics and Game reports must be completed on the provided documents as advised during the pre-season meetings.

Under 11's to Open Divisions and Warehouse Teams

Match Results and player Statistics must be directly enter through MyCricket manually after each match or by using the live scoring apps.

Newsletter Reports can be emailed to accc.news@albanycreekcricketclub.com.au

Our Statistician relies on the submission of match statistics to accurately allocate season awards and to ensure players receive recognition on reaching career milestones as the occur.

The newsletter can not report on player achievements unless that is communicated to us via a game report. In a nutshell, we can not recognise what we don't know about. Significant milestones such as hat-tricks or centuries can also be by emailing a photo of the player to us for inclusion in the newsletter and to be posted on the club's Facebook Page (parental permission required for players under 18 years of age).

Remember, our children are a mirror of our behaviour! Be mindful of yours when you are at a cricket match and/or training.

WET WEATHER ON MATCH DAYS

Brisbane North Junior Cricket very rarely makes a blanket cancellation as our reach extends from the city to Burpengary and being wet in one suburb does not mean the same in another.

Coaches/ Managers are advised to assess their home grounds prior to start of match and make a decision based on individual conditions.

Coaches/ Managers are advised to contact their opposition for match related information.

Friday Night Cricket: Grounds will be assessed in the early afternoon and match related decisions will be communicated to coaches/managers.

Unfortunately sometimes matches will be called off after teams arrive at the ground, that is rare to happen, but player safety and wellbeing is paramount and not negotiable.



THUNDER STORM 30/30 RULE

All coaches, managers, captains and anyone else with delegated responsibility for players, are instructed to exercise extreme caution during thunderstorms. The 30/30 rule is to be applied:

(a) if lightning and thunder are separated by a period of less than 30 seconds, the lightning is close enough to be a threat. You are to leave the field or training area immediately and seek shelter in a building or motor vehicle – *not under trees*.

(b) A period of 30 minutes should elapse before play is resumed, that is, after seeing the last lightning flash, wait 30 minutes before leaving shelter. If during this time lightning is again observed, contrary to the 30/30 rule, the 30 minutes will start again.

(c) Common sense should also prevail and caution must be exercised. If lightning is observed in your vicinity, leave the field. Do not hesitate to take the initiative and lead your players off if the opposition and/or umpires do not agree.

This regulation applies to all junior and senior matches. Safety of all involved is paramount and not negotiable





Guidelines for Heat, Hydration and Sun Protection

Heat

Climatic conditions vary throughout Australia and tolerance of heat and humidity varies significantly from one individual to another. Fortunately the majority of junior cricket matches are normally played before or after the hottest part of the day. However, players' health must always be considered in the scheduling of matches.

Cricket Australia recommends that Clubs, Schools and Associations apply common sense guidelines to climatic conditions that exist within their respective regions and consult with the Sports Medicine Australia branch within their state or territory to assist in the development of local policies.

Hydration

No single recommendation on the volume of fluid to be consumed is appropriate due to the vast range of body composition, fitness, and states of acclimatisation represented in childhood and adolescence.

More fluid appears to be consumed by young people when the drinks offered are perceived as palatable to them. Regular and effective drinking practices should become habitual to young athletes before, during, and after activity.

Guidelines for fluid replacement:

- Drinks breaks occur every 30 – 60 minutes in all matches (every 30 minutes in conditions of extreme temperature);
- Water is the most appropriate drink for re-hydration. However, diluted cordial or sports drinks may be supplied. Flavoured drinks may be particularly palatable to children who have consistently poor drinking habits during exercise;
- Drinks should be available for individual players between drinks breaks. Umpires should be advised that additional drinks are sought and players should make every effort to ensure no time is wasted;
- Players should be encouraged to have their own drink bottles. This ensures that each player has access to an adequate level of replacement fluids and reduces the risk of contamination and viruses; and
- Where cups and a large container are supplied, cups should not be dipped into the container. Used cups should be washed or disposed of after use.
- Do not share cups.

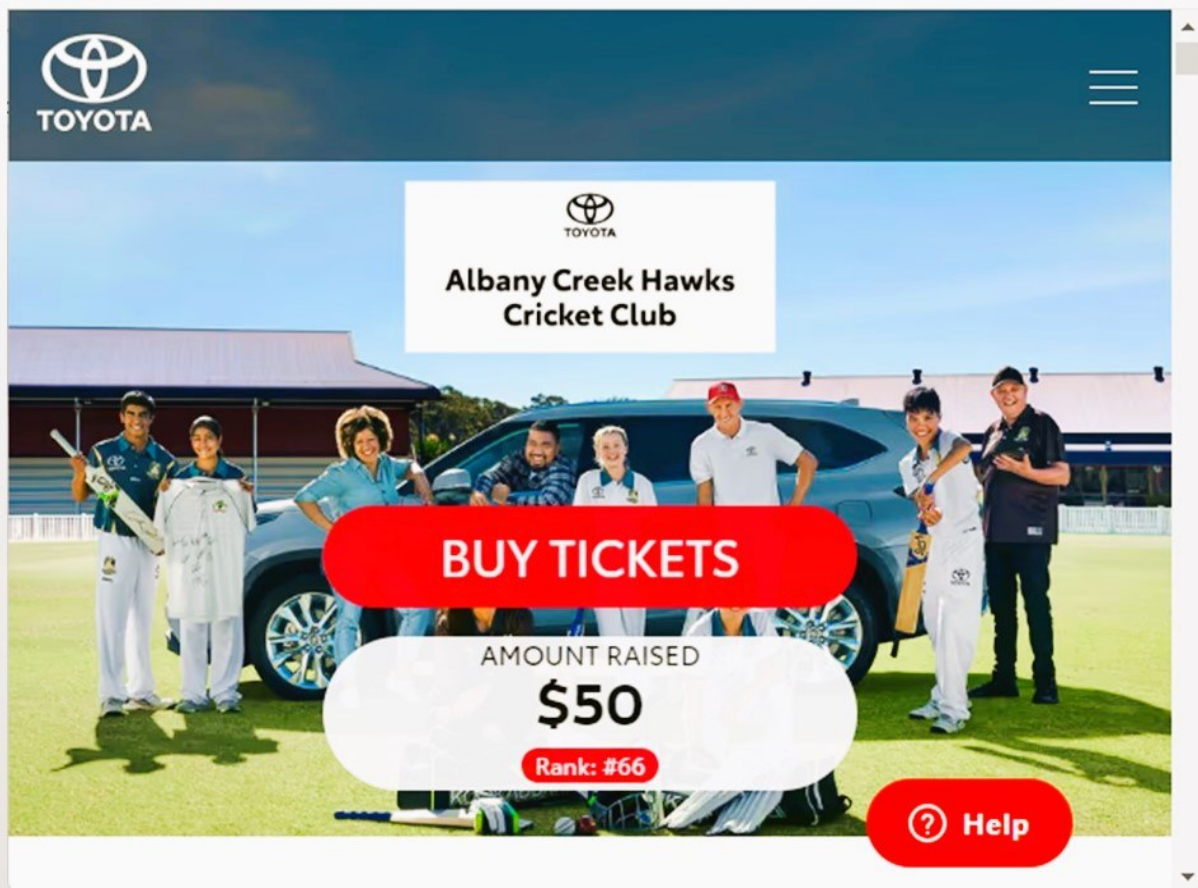
